



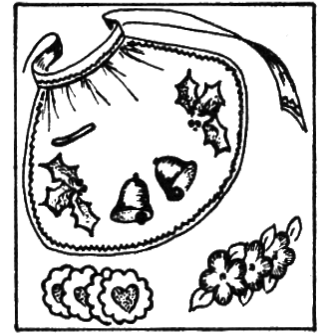
Christmas Door Knob Covers

My Christmas door knob covers of Santa sell on sight and are very popular with youngsters. Using 4-ply yarn, I crochet a plain cover to fit on doorknobs. I use a red ball fringe for nose and felt or outing flannel for hat. The tassel and beard are made of same thread as cover or face part. For eyes I use black sequins centered with a gold star and small bead. Up front of cap I use green sequins centered with smaller gold sequins and glass beads. I tuck cap to one side at top and tack down.



Christmas Tags

I take old Christmas cards and cut out suitable pictures the size of tags purchased for gifts. I edge them with gold or silver hobby paint.



Holiday Apron

My original holiday apron with snap-on trimmings has brought me many profitable orders. I make the half apron of broadcloth in many beautiful colors. It has one slot pocket and is trimmed around the edge, on tie ends and around reinforcement circles where snap is placed with metallic baby rick-rack. Each apron has 4 snap-on trimmings of felt, and these are trimmed with sequins and beads or tube glitter to suit one's fancy. I sell the apron with three sets of trimmings for \$3.25, or pattern and directions for 75c. Christmas trimmings consist of 2 bells and 2 sprays of holly. For card parties, the 4 card symbols are used. Valentine's day, hearts of course, shamrock for March, pumpkins and black cats for October. Stars and flowers are very lovely and may be used any time. If desired I make any 4 letter name such as Edna, Mary, Nora, etc. I have also made them for birthdays.
